Our Executive Director, Kathleen Wood and I attend community meetings and Kathleen has a team of talented graduate student volunteer interns who also attend meetings on our behalf and work on our website and social media, including Facebook, Twitter, TikTok, and Instagram. 



Redistricting is coming to Sherman Oaks!

Current Map of our local Council Districts



The Los Angeles City Council Redistricting Commission 2021, which is made up of twenty-one persons including members of the public, is currently viewing several draft maps for the redistricting.

Redistricting happens every ten years following a census. The district boundaries will be redrawn so that each district is substantially equal in population.

While normally this process happens in March, it has been delayed due to the pandemic.

It happened over the summer on Wednesday June 9th, and it was reported to feel like a short, rattling jolt.

The US Geological Survey reported that a 2.0 magnitude earthquake struck at 3:45am..

Its' epicenter was in the heart of the Sherman Oaks area near Valley Vista Boulevard, between Kester Avenue and Van Nuys Boulevard. The quake's depth was measured as 1.4 miles.

To remove unwanted persons from private property:

Post a no trespassing sign (see example below). You must ensure proper signage has been posted in accordance with Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 41.24 (a) AND file a *Trespass Arrest Authorization Form* with the LAPD. Please keep a copy for yourself.
