
# VILLAGE AT SHERMAN OAKS BID NEWSLETTER 3rd Quarter 2022

Following an evaluation of the pilot period, we've decided to not extend the pilot into a permanent Ventura Team program. Instead, we will be leveraging our existing homelessness service provider contracts to provide support to businesses and PEH along Ventura.
