



Graffiti Removal:

File a 311 request at <u>https://www.lacity.org/myla311</u> or on the MyLA311 App, or call 311.

To remove unwanted persons from private property:

Post a no trespassing sign (see example below). You must ensure proper signage has been posted in accordance with Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 41.24 (a) AND file a *Trespass Arrest Authorization Form* with the Van Nuys LAPD. Please keep a copy and be prepared to show it to the responding officers to prove that you are aughorized to request the arrest.
